#### **PUBLICATIONS**

#### What are publications?

• Publications are guidebooks that allow you to gain skills on your projects. Some projects require the publication to complete your project for fair but for other projects the publications aren't really needed. If you need help making this decision please talk to your club leader or reach out to the Extension office.

#### Please only order the books you NEED!

• If you have books from the past couple of years that you would like to donate back to the Extension office so we can re-use them please drop them by!

#### To request an order:

• Everyone has to have their publication orders in by **March 1, 2023.** Once the publications arrive at our office we will contact your leader & deliver them to your club meetings.

YQCA is a training that is required by the state for all 4-H'ers who are exhibiting beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, or goats. you are required to take this training **each year**. We will schedule a few in-person trainings in early 2024, or you can take the training online. Look for more information to come on dates.

### **QUALITY ASSURANCE and ETHIC CERTIFICATION (QAEC)**

All 4-H'ers who are exhibiting horses, poultry, rabbits, dogs, & and cats MUST complete online QAEC to show at the fair. This is a **one-time** certification and is valid your entire 4-H career. You only need to take QAEC in one livestock area regardless of the number of livestock projects you are enrolled in. All new members enrolled in these projects and/or any members who have not taken it before must complete the certification by June 1. ### **GOAT WORKSHOP**



This is a hands-on experience for youth to learn about goat selection and how to get your goat project started. Topics such as early care, feed, facilities, health, and more will be covered. The main focus of this workshop will be on meat goats and dairy goats but information on pygmy goats can be provided. This workshop is open to all of Unit 25 (Edwards, Lawrence, Richland, Wabash & Wayne).

This will be on Saturday, March 9, 2024 from 10 am- 12 pm at the Wabash County Fairgrounds Livestock Barn located at 15039 Four H Lane, Mt. Carmel, IL 62863.

#### SHEEP & GOAT STATE FAIR NOMINATIONS

Exhibitors will self-nominate their lambs and goats by filling out a nomination form. They will include a close-up photo of the ear with the scrapie tag attached and readable. They will no longer be tattooed. The nomination form will be turned in to our office so we can sign it and send it to the State Extension Office.

These are due to our office by May 15th. Nomination forms can be picked up at the 4-H office or by emailing logank@illinois.edu.

#### **Performance Cows**

Owned and personally cared for by exhibitor since January 1, 2024

#### **SWINE - GILTS:**

• Owned by exhibitor since May 1, 2024

#### **SHEEP - EWES & RAMS:**

• Owned and personally cared for by exhibitor since May 1, 2024

#### **DAIRY - COWS AND HEIFERS:**

- Calves and Heifers Owned since May 1, 2024
- Cows Owned since January 1, 2024









## **Breeding Animals Continued**

#### **HORSE & PONY:**

On or before May 1, 2024

#### DOGS:

Dogs must be owned or leased by June 1, 2024



#### **DAIRY GOATS:**


- Kids and Yearlings not in milk must be owned by exhibitor only by May 1, 2024.
- Milking Does must be owned by exhibitor only by January 1, 2024.

#### **MEAT GOATS**


• All meat goats (market and all breeding animals) are to be owned by exhibitor only by May 1, 2024.


#### **RABBITS, NOVELTY GOATS & POULTRY:**

• Animals in these species that are to be exhibited at the ISF Jr. Show must be owned by the exhibitor as indicated: Does -- By June 1 of the year exhibiting; All others -- Out of stock owned by the exhibitor prior to June 1, 2024.







### FARM CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS



Thirty \$2,500 Agriculture Scholarships are available to high school seniors who will study an ag-related curricula or trade in a college or vocational school next fall and pursue a career on the farm or in the industry. ## FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS



#### **Scholarships**

- Available to MCHS graduates; high school students may only apply for one scholarship
- \$2000 scholarship and \$1000 scholarship available to high school seniors and current college students pursuing a degree in agriculture
- \$1000 scholarship available to high school seniors pursuing a non-ag degree
- Applications can be found on the Wabash County 4-H website and must be turned in to the Farm Bureau office by April 15, 2024

#### Grants

- Available to 4-H members ages 8-12 (as of September 1, 2023)
- \$25-\$100 grants to be used for materials needed for 4-H projects (including supplies for livestock care and show, but cannot be used to purchase an animal)
- Application must be hand-written by 4-H member, signed by a parent, and signed by the club leader
- Applications & guidelines can be found on the Wabash County 4-H website and must be turned in to the Farm Bureau office by April 15, 2024
