Wabash County Fair Dates: July 12 - 20, 2024

Mark your calendars and make plans to attend now!

Reminders:

• Every 4-H'er will be required to attend **FOUR** 4-H events to be eligible to show at the fair. This can be club meetings or workshops that the extension office holds.





YQCA is a training that is required by the state for all 4-H'ers who are exhibiting beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, or goats. you are required to take this training **each year**. Wabash County will offer two in-person trainings, or members can take the training online, or with another county. Wabash County training dates are March 26th at 10:00 am and April 11th at 6:00 pm. Both trainings will be held at the Annex Building at the Fairgrounds.

QUALITY ASSURANCE and ETHIC CERTIFICATION (QAEC)

All 4-H'ers who are exhibiting horses, poultry, rabbits, dogs, & and cats MUST complete online QAEC to show at the fair. This is a **one-time** certification and is valid your entire 4-H career. You only need to take QAEC in one livestock area regardless of the number of livestock projects you are enrolled in. All new members enrolled in these projects and/or any members who have not taken it before must complete the certification by June 1. Please remember to print a copy of your certificate for your records. If you have trouble or questions, please call the Extension office.

Rabbit Classes

Wabash County 4-H rabbit novelty and commercial classes will be following the American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) breed guide this year. If your rabbit breed is listed in the four class you will sign up for novelty classes. If your rabbit breed is listed in the six class you will sign up for commercial classes. The breed guide can be found on the Wabash County 4-H website, under Fair and Show Information. Please contact our office if you have any questions!











OWNERSHIP, HEALTH, & REGISTRATION PAPERS

Wabash County 4-H will not be requiring ownership forms this year. All other required health papers and purebred registration papers will be inspected at fair check-in like normal. Failure to have health papers during weigh-in/check-in on Sunday, July 14th at 2:00 p.m. may cause:

1) Inability to exhibit livestock

2) \$275 vet charge for turning in papers late.

Breeding Animals

BEEF - HEIFERS AND COWS:

Heifers

• Owned and personally cared for by exhibitor since May 1, 2024 (with the exception of Junior Heifer and Bull Calf)

Performance Cows

Owned and personally cared for by exhibitor since January 1, 2024







Breeding Animals Continued

SWINE - GILTS:

• Owned by exhibitor since May 1, 2024

SHEEP - EWES & RAMS:

• Owned and personally cared for by exhibitor since May 1, 2024

DAIRY - COWS AND HEIFERS:

- Calves and Heifers Owned since May 1, 2024
- Cows Owned since January 1, 2024

HORSE & PONY:

• On or before May 1, 2024

DOGS:

• Dogs must be owned or leased by June 1, 2024

DAIRY GOATS:

- Kids and Yearlings not in milk must be owned by exhibitor only by May 1, 2024.
- Milking Does must be owned by exhibitor only by January 1, 2024.

MEAT GOATS

• All meat goats (market and all breeding animals) are to be owned by exhibitor only by May 1, 2024.

RABBITS, NOVELTY GOATS & POULTRY:

• Animals in these species that are to be exhibited at the ISF Jr. Show must be owned by the exhibitor as indicated: Does -- By June 1 of the year exhibiting; All others -- Out of stock owned by the exhibitor prior to June 1, 2024.

SHEEP & GOAT STATE FAIR NOMINATIONS

Exhibitors will self-nominate their lambs and goats by filling out a nomination form. They will include a close-up photo of the ear with the scrapie tag attached and readable. They will no longer be tattooed. The nomination form will be turned in to our office so we can sign it and send it to the State Extension Office.


These are due to our office by May 15th. Nomination forms can be picked up at the 4-H office or by emailing logank@illinois.edu.

SWINE WORKSHOP

There will be a swine workshop on May 4th at the Wabash County Fairgrounds from 10am-noon. FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

Scholarships



- Available to MCHS graduates; high school students may only apply for one scholarship
- \$2000 scholarship and \$1000 scholarship available to high school seniors and current college students pursuing a degree in agriculture
- \$1000 scholarship available to high school seniors pursuing a non-ag degree
- Applications can be found on the Wabash County 4-H website and must be turned in to the Farm Bureau office by April 15, 2024

Grants

- Available to 4-H members ages 8-12 (as of September 1, 2023)
- \$25-\$100 grants to be used for materials needed for 4-H projects (including supplies for livestock care and show, but cannot be used to purchase an animal)
- Application must be hand-written by 4-H member, signed by a parent, and signed by the club leader
- Applications & guidelines can be found on the Wabash County 4-H website and must be turned in to the Farm Bureau office by April 15, 2024
