

BOONE COUNTY 4-H HORSE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide some financial assistance to a current deserving 4-H Horse project member who has evidenced scholarly achievement and leadership ability. Boone County Horse Committee will award one individual with a \$250 Scholarship.

Criteria:

- 1. Must have achieved in a horse project and submitted 4-H horse project records for a minimum of 2 years.
- 2. Must be enrolled in a 4-H horse project the current year of the application.
- 3. The applicant must be a graduating senior or graduated senior.
- 4. The applicant is only eligible to win the scholarship once.
- 5. Not based on financial need.
- 6. Paid to the applicant or a College, Jr. College, or Trade School on proof of registration.
- 7. Please attach your county award application in the horse project area.
