TO: Potential Dog Trainers

RE: Dog Obedience classes beginning June 5

Because of your interest in dogs, here is some information you may want to know. University of Illinois Extension will sponsor a Dog Obedience School beginning on June 5 at the Fulton County Fairgrounds in Lewistown, at 6:00 p.m. near the cattle arena. Our instructor again this year is Danette Phelps. There will be four sessions, on June 5, 12, 19, and 26, all of which are Wednesdays. If not enough people sign up, it will be canceled.

The cost to participate is \$30 for youth ages 8-18, and \$60 for adults. Checks are to be made payable to Danette Phelps. There are no refunds once classes have begun. This is an <u>optional</u> activity that 4-H members may wish to participate in, and is not required.

Main Points To Note:

- 1. Pups under 6 months of age are not eligible. However, if the pup is close to 6 months old, and is mature enough, an exception may be made.
- Your dog must have active rabies, distemper, and Parvo Virus shots for your protection and as a courtesy to others. YOU <u>MUST</u> ATTACH A COPY OF THE RABIES SLIP TO THE REGISTRATION FORM. If you do not, your dog cannot attend.
- 3. A six-foot leather lead is required for the training sessions. No chain leashes are allowed.
- 4. A chain slip collar or "choke chain" will be the training collar. One other type that is allowed is the Gentle Leader.
- 5. One handler per dog is recommended. Each handler must be able to properly handle their own dog in a class setting.
- 6. The training classes will be held rain or shine. However, be aware that we would cancel the class if <u>severe</u> weather is present -- there is usually not sufficient time to call everyone. Use your own judgment before coming to class if that occurs.
- 7. We reserve the right to ask anyone with a dog of questionable personality to use a muzzle or pinch collar on their dog -- at the owner's expense.

Any dogs that are a danger to others are not allowed, regardless of the breed.
