## Animal Livestock Ownership Dates

Ownership dates for animals is as follows:

**January 1, 2021**: Market Steers & Heifers, Dairy cows, Milking goat

April 1, 2021: Market (meat) & Novelty Goats, Swine, Breeding Heifers, Horses

May 1, 2021: Bucket Calf

May 15, 2021: Market lambs, Breeding sheep

June 1, 2021: Dogs, rabbits, poultry, pygmy goats

The above dates are when all 4-H'ers with these projects

must have the animals in their possession.

## If you are Showing Swine.....

All 4-H'ers enrolled in Swine that are showing a Market Hog at Fair MUST have an Extension issued Ear Tag that can be picked up at the Extension Office. You can tag up to 5 Market Hogs but are only allowed to show 1 in the Market and Purebred Barrow class. You're Market and Purbred

hog MUST have an Extension issued tag in its ear to show at Fair. Please have paperwork back to the Extension office by May 1st. You can pick up the tags starting April 1st!



# Quality Assurance and Ethics Certification (QAEC)

All 4-H members enrolled in beef, dairy, goats, horses, poultry, swine, sheep, rabbits, dogs & cats MUST complete online QAEC to show at Fair. This rule applies to 4-H Members who exhibit live animals AND poster exhibits.

This is a one time certification and is valid your entire 4-H career. You only need to take QAEC in one livestock area regardless of the number of livestock projects you are enrolled in. The deadline to complete QAEC is JUNE 1.
