Attention Poultry Exhibitors!

As show season approaches, protecting poultry health is paramount for ensuring a safe environment for all. Pullorum testing detects this contagious disease, safeguarding flocks and preventing its spread and is now required for all birds (except water fowl) that will be exhibited at 2024 shows and fairs.

Animal Project 4-H Policy

All exhibitors in Beef, Dairy, Goat, Sheep, and/or Swine are required to complete Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) certification, annually via yqcaprogram.org This training may be completed in-person or online, fees vary. **Certification deadline is July 15.**

Exhibitors in Dog, Horse, Poultry and/or Rabbit are required to complete Quality Assurance & Ethics

(QAEC), available through 4h.ZSuite.com. This includes the five main sections AND an individual species section. Certification need only be done once. Certification deadline is July 15

Horses—Ownership and Lease papers and photos were due to the U of I Extension office by April 15.

ISF Jr. Horse Show entries are due to Extension office by June 14, 2024.

ISF Livestock Jr. Show Entries are due by JUNE 29, 2024.

Parade of Banners

All Tazewell County 4-H Clubs are invited to participate in the Parade of Banners on Tuesday, July 30. It will be right after the Livestock Parade in the Livestock Arena.

Each club may select one or two banner carriers (who are NOT in the Livestock Parade). The banner carriers should meet at 5:55 PM in the Livestock Arena to line up and receive directions.

The Parade of Banners is a great way to get 4-H members involved in the fair and leadership responsibilities. You can use it to encourage new members or members who want an easy way to be involved.

Fair Entry Deadline—July 1

To register for the Tazewell 4-H Show, you will use the online FairEntry.com system. It strongly recommended to complete it EARLY. The Registration deadline is 11:59 PM on Monday, July 1, 2024.

Tazewell 4-H members must be enrolled in 4-H program by May 1 to be eligible to register for the 4-H Show. 4-H members must be enrolled in the correlating project to take an exhibit to the 4-H Show. Use the 2024 Show Book to register! All exhibits must be registered by the July 1 deadline to be considered for awards, premiums, and State Fair.

NOTE: Please keep in mind that FairEntry has limitations in its settings. Thus, we will be using the rules as printed in the Show Book as our established guidelines for the show.

Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her own entry. All Tazewell County youth are eligible to enter classes for the Tazewell Jr. Fair. 4-H membership and project enrollment are not required.

Fair Entry is Now Open

ALL Tazewell County 4-H members planning on exhibiting at the 2024 Tazewell 4-H Show & Jr. Fair will need to register for their eligible exhibit opportunities by July 1.
