Important Reminders:



- Every 4-H'er will be required to attend FOUR 4-H meetings this year in order to show at the fair. This can be club meetings or workshops that the extension office hosts.
- Livestock must be in place at the Wabash County Fairgrounds by 2pm on Sunday July 17th. Members who do not comply with this rule will be disqualified from exhibiting.

Ownership Forms

At this point everyone should have received their livestock folder with the ownership forms at your club meeting. If you were not in attendance at your March club meeting please reach out to the extension office or your club leader to get those. As the form states your large livestock (cattle, dairy, swine, sheep, & goats) must have some form of an identification (tag, tattoo, and notches are excepted if they are a purebred pig).

For Swine, Beef, Sheep, Goat, and Horses yours are due May 3rd.

For Cat & Dog forms are due June 1st.

Off-Premise Form

In certain instances, members may keep their livestock on property other than their own. The member is required to submit a livestock Off-Premises Form to the Extension office for approval (including horses). As noted on the form, the 4-H member is responsible for the daily care and feeding of his or her animal project. This form must be submitted to the extension office by June 1st, 2022.
