Make the ending word of each line rhyme, go free verse and make it sound like you like, make it a haiku (where the first line has five syllables, the second has seven syllables, and the third has five syllables.) Or write a different kind of poem! Write three different poems using three different prompts to make it a tic tac toe – go across, up and down or diagonal. Try to write three different kinds of poems!
