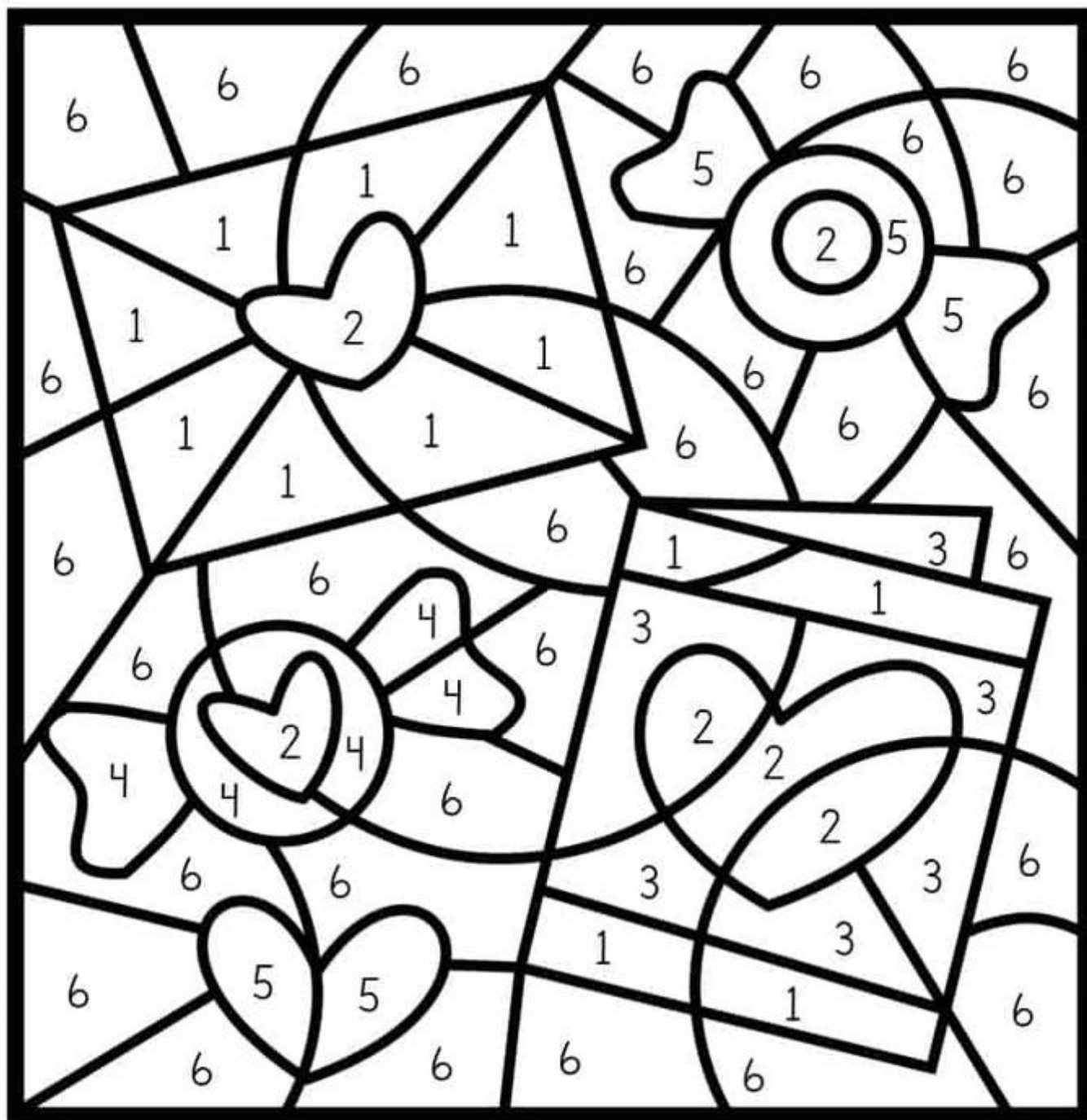

Valentine's Day Color by Number

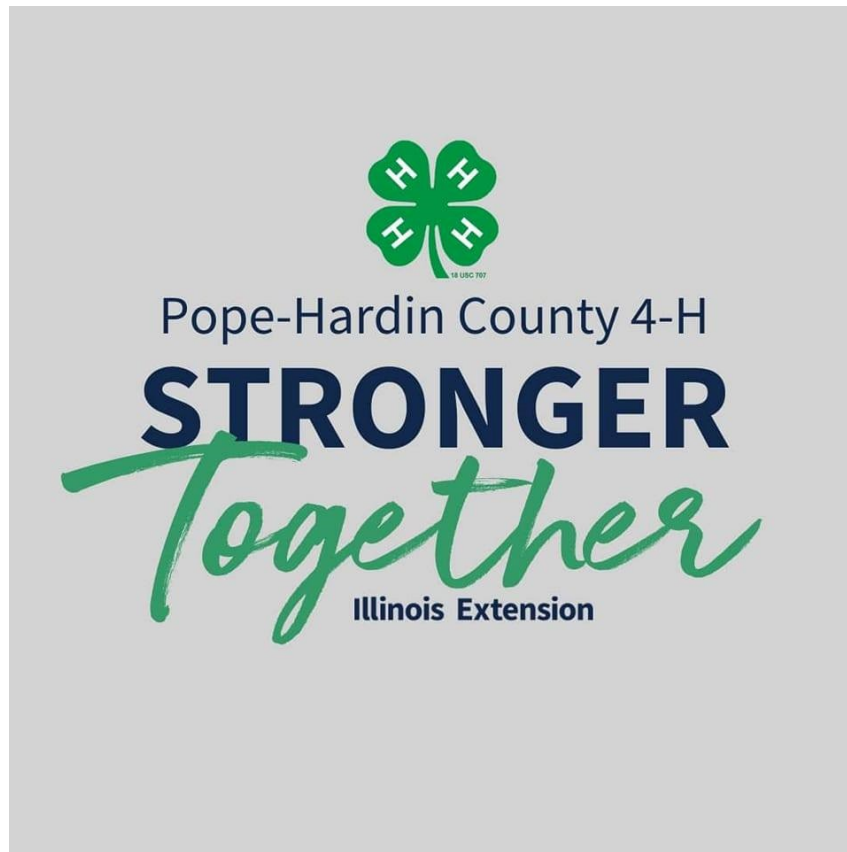
