















Kindergarten Offerings:































 This lesson is designed to help students understand the apple growth process and introduces seasons and the role of pollinators. Students gain an understanding of how apples are produced while creating a hands-on craft.



• Our sheep lesson features a picture book about sheep, followed by a craft activity where students make sheep figurines using cotton balls and paper. This combination of reading and creating helps children learn about sheep in a fun, hands-on way.

Circle of Earth Bracelet

 Kindergarteners will read a picture book about recycling and create bracelets using beads to represent key Earth-friendly concepts. This engaging mix of reading, activities, and crafting helps foster a sense of environmental responsibility.

Farm Flipbook

 In this lesson, students will complete a pre-designed flip book focused on farm animals—horses, pigs, poultry, and cows. Through interactive pages, they'll learn key facts about each animal, enhancing their understanding of farm life while enjoying a hands-on, educational activity.

Farm Animals and Barn Mobile

o Students will match farm products to their animal sources. They'll then get creative by designing their own barnyard in a craft activity, combining learning about farm life with imaginative play.

Farm Boots

Students will read Farm Boots by Lisl H. Detlefsen and design their own pair while learning why farmers wear different boots for different jobs.

Pig Applesauce Cups

Students will read Pigs by Gail Gibbons and create pig faces using applesauce cups, buttons, googly eyes, paper ears, and curly tails blending literacy, nutrition, and craft in a fun, hands-on activity.
