• FY25 Budget

Katie gave a presentation and updates for FY25 Budget. Detailed discussions, questions, comments and answers were followed during the presentation.

### • FY25 Budget

The spreadsheet for income will be seen as off balance due to some of the items still missing, however, it will show up after the calendar year. Some off balance items will be McLean County – McLean is still in a deficit.

- o Mileage/per diem due to the increase
- o Minimum wage due to increase will not impact us now, but will in the summer due to the hiring of the summer help

Transferring of funds – matching funds received and disbursed evenly to each County to balance out a little bit more

Livingston County and Woodford County Budgets are good.

FY26 Budget approved for July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026 in November 2024 by the County Board. Those are the budget numbers for FY26 as listed.

We are fully funded by the State Budget at the moment

We will request more funding for FY27
