FY25 Budget

#### FY25 Budget

- We're usually one month behind to reconciling the budget. Most likely we haven't received October's yet from the University to compare it. Livingston and Woodford County looks good.
- o As of now, McLean County ended September with \$76,000.00 in deficit.
- After speaking with Leadership on Campus, it was assured once the match dollars and and Smith Lever funds comes in, the deficit will be a little smaller. Eventually within the next two years, it'll be back to normal.
- o June to July salary and wages seems less than August and September it's because of the rollover of the fiscal year from June 30 into July 1.
- Have not received County Board payment from McLean County, as of yet, there's an issue with the auditor making payments, however, it's in the works for us to being paid. Livingston and Woodford County payments have been received.
- An email was received recently saying our matched dollars have come throught, which will be put into the account as well to to cover payments.
