Project Selection – due December

Winter

Give a talk/demonstration
Consider serving on a club or county committee to gain some leadership skills
Sign up for upcoming workshops and spin clubs

Spring

Animal and Livestock members – complete your online QAEC training (once per career)
Livestock members (beef, dairy, goat, swine, sheep) – complete your <u>YQCA</u> training annually
Access and read the show handbook
Watch for instructions regarding project entry into the fair – due May

Summer

Exhibit your project at a culminating event and/or fair
Submit County Award Applications – due August
