Quilting Workshop Series

At this fun two-part workshop series, you'll turn leftover 4-H shirts into a cozy keepsake quilt!

Hosted at the Knox Agri Center, 180 S. Soangetaha Rd, Galesburg, IL Date: Part 1: January 31, 2026; Part 2: February 14, 2026, 9 AM – 12 PM (both sessions)

During Session 1, you'll learn how to piece together your quilt top by cutting the shirts, utilizing fabric stabilizer, and preparing your backing and batting. You'll put it all together in Session 2 by sewing your quilt top to your backing and batting, quilt the outside border of your blanket, and hand tie your quilt. We strongly encourage you to attend both sessions to get the most out of your experience.

If you have your own sewing machine, please bring it to the workshop to practice on. If you don't have a sewing machine, we have several you may request to use for the workshop.

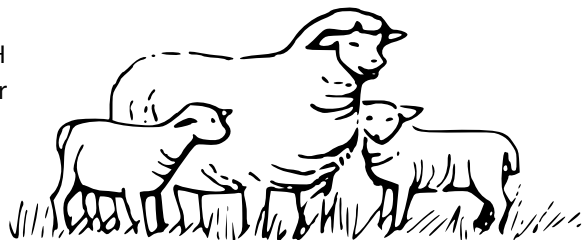

BUILDING BRICK CHALLENGE SERIES

4-Hers ages 8 and up, don't miss your chance to compete in our virtual building brick challenge series, where you can show off best original builds with plastic building bricks like LEGO and MEGABLOKS! The December contest theme is "Habitats" - small, diorama-style scenes featuring a minifigure, built on an 8x8 plate base. This is the last monthly challenge in our series this year, which celebrates the launch of our new Creating with Building Bricks 4-H project. Each month, our favorite build (based on creativity, technical skills demonstrated, and alignment to theme) will be selected as the winner in 3 different age divisions: junior (8-10 years old), intermediate (11-13 years old), and senior (14-18 years old). We'll also select one random participant submission per month to receive some swag. There is no cost to enter, but youth MUST be currently enrolled Illinois 4-H club members to participate. State Horse Judging Contest

The 2026 4-H State Horse Judging Contest is scheduled for SUNDAY, February 1 at Black Hawk East College in Galva, IL, with a 1 PM start (12:30 PM check-in). Contest rules and more details can be found on the state 4-H website. Note that this contest takes place on the Galva, IL East campus of Black Hawk College, not at Black Hawk's main campus in Moline.

4-H members are invited to learn about horses all while developing life skills such as objective reasoning, decision-making, public speaking, and teamwork at the Illinois 4-H State Horse Judging Contest. The primary objective of these contests is to provide an opportunity for youth to demonstrate their knowledge of equine-related subject matter in a competitive setting where attitudes of friendliness and fairness prevail.

In the 4-H State Horse Judging Contest youth will judge six classes of horses, at least two being halter classes. Youth 14 years of age and older may also choose to participate in oral reasons following the classes. For those not participating in the oral reasons class, one questions class will be required. Top-placing senior division youth will be invited to participate in an invitational judging contest after which the national team will be determined. This judging contest is also home to the Larry Carls Memorial Overall High Point Award which will be given to the 4-H horse judging contest participant who earns the highest % of total possible points across both contest divisions (reasons & non-reasons).
