

Cumberland County 4-H Ginger Kuhn Memorial Scholarship Application

Guidelines

1. Applicants must have been in 4-H for at least one year, but do not have to be a current 4-H member.
2. Scholarship applications may be submitted by anyone who has graduated high school up to 20 years of age.
3. The application must be returned to the Cumberland County Extension office by September 15.
4. The scholarship is open to anyone who is establishing a business, pursuing trade school, becoming an apprentice, or pursuing a certificate.
5. The application should be typed or printed neatly. Incomplete or illegible applications may not be reviewed.
6. Parent/guardian signature is required.
7. Scholarship will be awarded during the Cumberland County 4-H Achievement Program.
