



2019-2020 4-H Member Agreement

The Youth Development staff have reviewed the 4-H enrollment policy for McLean County 4-H members and have come to the following consensus.

All McLean County 4-H members must attend at least three club meetings or Club/4-H activities and give a talk or demonstration at the club level to be considered an active member of McLean County 4-H and be able to participate at the local 4-H Show. These requirements must be met between September 1 and June 28 of the current 4-H year.

In addition to the above meeting requirements, the following enrollment deadlines must be met by all 4-H members of Livingston, McLean and Woodford counties. All returning 4-H members must be enrolled in at least one 4-H project, paid their \$20 4-H program fee, and returned required documents (*membership agreement and liability waiver*) to the Extension office to be considered active, covered by University Insurance and receive future communications from the Extension office. Members will have until April 15 of the current 4-H year to add or drop 4-H projects. All new 4-H members must be enrolled in all of their 4-H projects and pay their 4-H program fee to the Extension office by April 15 of the current 4-H year in order to show in the local 4-H Show.

Only active McLean County 4-H members will be allowed to participate in the McLean County 4-H Show.
