October 1, 2020	Outstanding 4-H Growth Award	 <i>Electronic submission</i> by Club Leader Club Leaders (ONLY) nominate 4-H members ages 9 -13 as of September 1st. Leaders may nominate as many members as they would like but, final decision will be made by Extension staff if more than one nominee is submitted in the same area. October 1, 2020	Outstanding First Year 4-H Member Award	 <i>Electronic submission</i> by 4-H member <u>Application</u> One boy and one girl are selected. Applicants must be age 8 to 10 by Sept. 1 in the year they are applying for. Do not include any Cloverbud materials in application

October 1, 2020	Emanuel Johnson Award	 <i>Electronic submission</i> by Club Leader Club Leaders (ONLY) nominate individuals who have provided leadership to the club and county. Nominees must be entering their junior or senior year of high school. To nominate, the club Leaders write a short summary of the leadership the nominee provided for the club. Leaders please fill out this application by clicking <u>here.</u>
October 1, 2020	Marvin Kottman Award	 <i>Electronic submission</i> by 4-H member <u>Application</u> Applicants must be entering or completing their senior year of high School. Member must have been enrolled in agricultural projects such as Animal Sciences, Plant & Soil, Crop Sciences, Horticulture or Natural Resources.
