- 1. Applicants must be current or past DeKalb County 4-H members, who are high school seniors or in an approved post-high school educational program (junior college, 4-year university, trade school, etc.). Applicants should also be a fulltime student.
- 2. The number of recipients shall be determined by the DeKalb County 4-H Foundation. Scholarship will be a \$500 scholarship paid directly to the scholarship recipient's college upon receipt of proof of enrollment in an approved post-high school educational program. Once a member has been awarded this scholarship they are ineligible to reapply.
- 3. **All applications are due by 4 p.m. on Friday, April, 24.** Application should be typed or neatly written.
- 4. Applicants will be **REQUIRED** to participate in an interview. The interview date is TBD. Applicants will be contacted for an interview day & time.
- 5. The application must include one reference letter (Not from an Extension staff member). Reference letters should address applicant's leadership, teamwork, citizenship, and interpersonal skills. Reference letters should NOT be from individuals related to the applicant.
