## Workshop Descriptions

### Balloon Animals

**Instructor:** Allyson Aves

**Description:** Learn to shape balloons into a variety of fun animal shapes. **Cost \$1**

### Beginner Greeting Cards

**Description:** Do you enjoy receiving homemade cards, but wish you knew how to create them too? Learn simple card making techniques including stamping, layering, card design, use of different card stock and scrap booking paper and how a little bit of ribbon can make all the difference. Take home completed cards which can be sent to family and friends. **Cost: \$5**

### Basic Robotics

**Instructor:** Boone Co. 4-H Lego Robotics Club

**Description:** Learn the basic components of robots and some simple programming, using EV3's and Cue Robots. 4-H'ers will also learn how to use digital designer. You will be using the robotics club equipment to learn the programming, you will not be taking the robotics home. Programming is a great skill to learn. **No Cost**

Dryer balls are chemical free and can be used for a long time in the dryer. **Cost \$5**

### Corsage & Boutonniere Workshop (2 Hour Class)

**Description:** Do you love fresh flowers? Are you interested in making flower arrangements? We will be making miniature flower arrangements and turning them into little corsages/boutonnieres. **Description:** Learn the two most basic stitches you need to sew! We will be making a small pillow using the basic sewing techniques, no sewing machine required! You will need to bring 3 or 4 quilters squares, a coordinating roll of thread, and a small bag of poly/fiber fill. **No Cost**

### Intermediate & Advanced Greeting Cards Ages 12 & Up

**Instructor:** Abigail Rozanas

**Description:** Do you already know basic card making skills, but want to expand your creativity? We will focus more on using brads, eyelets, embossing, chalks, and different types of twine to elevate your card making abilities. We will focus on how to create unique gift tags and envelopes. Take home your creations. **Cost \$8**

### Introduction to Alpacas

**Instructor:** Vicki Donley

**Description:** Alpacas are cute and fuzzy, but where do they come from and what are they used for? This class will answer these questions as well about showing Alpacas. There will be samples of their fiber, tools used for the processing their fiber, and more. **No Cost**

### Introduction to Drop Spindle Ages 10 & Up – (2 Hour Class)

**Instructor:** Vicki Donley

**Description:** Learn how to hand card alpaca fiber and use a drop spindle. We will use hand cards to make rolags and spin fiber into yarn using a drop spindle. "Get the feel" of the fiber and how using teamwork can produce yarn. You will make a braided bracelet to take home with the yarn we create. **Cost: \$3**

### Light It Up!

**Instructor:** Johnna Jennings, 4-H Youth Educator

**Description:** In this class, you will learn about electricity, how it flows, the difference between conductors and insulators, and LED lights. You will make paper circuits using conductive tape, and wire a simple light up dinosaur using LED lights. **No Cost**

### Jump Rope Making

**Instructor:** Carl & Willard Rozanas

**Description:** Do you enjoy recycling and creating fun and exciting things to play with? Learn how to easily make amazing jump ropes from old t-shirts. We may even have a jump roping contest! In addition, you will also learn how to create a bracelet using the same technique. Please bring 2 T-shirts that are size adult medium or larger and with minimal writing or design on them. **No Cost**

### Marshmallow Shooters

**Description:** Come to this workshop and make your own marshmallow shooter out of PVC pipes. Have fun shooting miniature marshmallows at targets just by blowing. **Cost \$5**

### Noodle Making

### Sewing: Up-cycle Placement Into a Bag

**Description:** Using a sewing machine, you will create a bag using a fabric placemat, web belting and trims. Bring your own machine or use one of ours! You will need to bring: 1 fabric rectangle placemat (@14X19); 32" of web belting; 30" ribbon, tassels, lace or trims for top edge of your bag; coordinating spool of thread; basic sewing notions. **No Cost**

### Sewing: Up-cycle Pot Holder Towel Oven Hanger

**Instructor:** Toni Baumann & Sue Berggren

**Description:** Using a sewing machine, you will create a towel that can be conveniently hung on your oven door. You will make this using a potholder, kitchen towel and a button. All materials will be provided for this class. **Cost: \$3**

### Snow Globes

**Description:** Bring a little bit of winter inside. Using a glass mason jar you will add small figurines, then add water, glue and glitter to make your very own little snow globe. You might even learn a little science along the way. **Cost: \$3**
