Delayed Entries for 2020: July dates TBD

University of Illinois Extension will be making a decision concerning August 4-H Shows on July 1 (whether they may take place 'in-person' or will be shifted to a 'virtual show' format). Due to that, the Logan County 4-H Show Fair Entry registration process will be delayed for 2020 only. All entries for Logan County 4-H Shows should be completed through ONLINE Fair Entry system (https://logan4-hfair.fairentry.com) in July (dates TBD).



Home & Family/Food, Nutrition & Health Shows - NEW DATE - August 1!

These shows will be held on **Saturday, August 1.** (Saturday ahead of Logan County Fair Week)

Home & Family Show will begin at 10 am in the Logan County Fair Special Events Building (Brown Door) at south end of Fairgrounds. The following projects will be exhibited: Clothing, Interior Design, Family Heritage, Consumer Ed (Financial Champions, Entrepreneurship), Child Development, and Communications (Communications, Creative Writing, Journalism). After judging they will be left on display for week of Fair.

The Food, Nutrition, & Health Show will begin at Noon at the Logan County 4-H Office Meeting Room. The following projects will be exhibited: Foods, Food Decorating & Health. After judging youth will be asked to take them to Special Events Fair Building (yellow door) to stay on display during week of Fair

Virtual 4-H Show exhibit requirements (if needed)

Should Logan 4-H Shows become 'virtual format' the requirements for exhibits will consist of photos (or short video or slideshow) and a one page report on the 4-H project (depending on the project area/s) which will be uploaded into online FairEntry system as PART OF ENTRY PROCESS - entries cannot be submitted without the required items for virtual exhibit. Additional details will be provided to members/families for each virtual project area exhibit requirement prior to FairEntry registration time. Work on projects early in the summer so they will be ready for photos and report upload should we need to move to the virtual format!

State Fair Livestock Books/Entries/Fees – deadline extended to July 15

Illinois State Fair Jr. Department books with classes & requirements are available only on the web. Jr. Livestock animal entry forms will also need to be printed off the web (these can be filled IN online before printing). State Fair Jr. Livestock Dept. entries will need to be submitted by 4-H member TO STATE FAIR. Due to State Fair by July 15. (NEW DATE) This year (2020 ONLY) staff will be unable to sign entry forms. Members choosing to submit their forms should print staff member name (Patty Huffer) on the signature line and submit their forms to the State Fair. The Illinois State Fair Junior Department will contact 4-H offices to verify 4-H enrollment after entries are made. Fees for 2020 Junior State Fair entries will be:
