## Reminders

- **YQCA**-This is required for all youth exhibiting Beef, Dairy, Goats (both Meat and Dairy), Sheep, and Swine must take this course.
  - You can take this course online for \$12 or you can take it in person for \$3.
    Either way you must register online for the event. You can do this by going to YQCA.org and use your 4-H online log-in.
  - In person Classes will be offered at the Anderson Building at the following times:
    - Thursday April 15<sup>th</sup>,2021 @6pm
    - Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup>,2021 @6pm
    - Saturday May 22<sup>nd</sup>,2021 @9am
  - EVERYONE must have this training completed by June 1<sup>st</sup>,2021 in order to be eligible to show at the Wabash County Fair.
- **QAEC** Anyone who is exhibiting a cat, dog, horse, poultry, or rabbit project for the first time must take this online training.
  - You can access this training at <u>http://web.extension.illinois.edu/qaec/</u>.
  - Must be completed by June 1<sup>st</sup>,2021.
- **Off Premis Forms** Anyone who is exhibiting livestock that is not being housed at your home address is required to fill out an off premis form and submit it to the extension office by May 1<sup>st</sup>,2021.
- Lease Form- If you are leasing a horse or dog for the Wabash County Fair you must complete our lease form and return it to the extension office by May 1<sup>st,</sup> 2021.
- **Registration papers** This year registration papers will be checked at the checkin process at the fair. In order for your animal to be placed in a purebred class your registration papers must be present.
- **Health papers-** Even though our fair is only a 1 day show this year health papers will still be REQUIRED.
- **Record Books-**Everyone exhibiting beef, swine, sheep, goats, dairy, rabbits, poultry, or horses is required to complete a record book and present it to us at check-in.
- Meeting attendance- Each 4-H'er will be required to attend at least 2 meetings by July 1<sup>st</sup>,2021
