- ❖ Discuss some workshops or extra learning opportunities that you participated in. For example, did you attend any workshops offered through Extension? What did you enjoy? What did you learn? How will it help you in real life? What workshops are you interested in attending?
- ❖ Discuss your 4-H club experiences. Did you enjoy your meetings? What kinds of activities did you do as a club? What would you like to do next year as a club? What do you like about your club and what would you change? If you were a club leader, what would you do differently?
- ❖ Discuss any community service projects that you did throughout the year either with your club or on your own. Tell us about the community service and the impact that it had on others.
- ❖ Discuss shows that you participated in such as county shows, state fair, livestock shows, etc. What was your experience like and what did you learn?
- ❖ Discuss any leadership opportunities that you took on this year. What did you learn about yourself? How were you able to help others throughout the year?
