This scholarship is sponsored by Cathy's husband Harold Ludolph and her family, along with the Peoria County 4-H Auction Committee.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a registered and approved Peoria County 4-H member, registered through ZSuite.
- Applicant must be enrolled in the project they are applying for by the time this application is turned in.
- Applicant must have a plan for what they will do, and what they would like to learn.
- Applicant must take their project for exhibit at the Peoria County 4-H Show of the 4-H year in which they are applying.
- Applicant must report back to the Peoria County 4-H Auction committee about what they learned and how they did.
- A thank you note must be sent after the 4-H Show.

To apply for this scholarship, please complete the form that includes: estimation of how much you are requesting for this particular project area and explains why you would like to do this project and what you would like to learn.

Funds will be dispersed amongst applicants, as determined by the Scholarship Committee. Applicants are not guaranteed to receive all the funds that they request.
