#### **Bred & Owned Classes**

We will be offering Bred & Owned Champion and Reserve Champion classes for Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Swine, Sheep, and Beef this year. There is no fee to enter.

To enter this class, the female must have been bred and the animal born and raised on your farm or property.

4-H members who wish to enter the Bred & Owned class can sign up the day of their species show. Youth may show one animal per class. Breeding and/or Market animals may be shown. Most species will have separate competitions for breeding and market classes.

The Bred & Owned class(es) for each species will be shown at the conclusion of each species show.

(These are not 4-H classes. No 4-H ribbons or premiums will be awarded.)











### **Master Showmanship**

**Attention: Livestock exhibitors...**Saline County 4-H will offer Master Showmanship at the Fair. This contest is open to any 4-H exhibitor who is 14-19 as of August 11, 2023.


Master Showmanship is a round robin contest where all participants show three species - beef, sheep, and swine. The winner of the Saline County contest will be eligible to compete at the Illinois State Fair Master Showmanship Contest on Friday, August 11, 2023 at 5:00 pm OR 30 minutes following the conclusion of the Supreme Heifer Show. Note there has been a time change.

Anyone interested in participating in Master Showmanship must call the office to register by July 1, 2023, so we can get a judge and make arrangements.



### **Get Totally Hooked!**

The 2023 Illinois 4-H Hooks Us Together Fishing Tournament is on, and June kicks off the Channel Catfish Challenge! What to do: Fish in the month of June and use a smartphone to take a picture of your catch. In the picture, you must clearly show the length of the fish in inches (take a picture of the fish with a tape measure for proof.)

### Youth Crop Scouting Competition

In a corn or soybean field, knowing how crops are progressing or being able to identify an insect can mean the difference between a profitable harvest and a bad year.

The Illinois Crop Scouting Competition is a one-day contest that challenges teams of students from across the state to test their field scouting knowledge hands-on with agricultural professionals from University of Illinois.



Teams of students (grades 9 through 12) accompanied by an adult advisor will rotate through 10 outdoor stations at the University of Illinois South Farm fields to test their skills hands-on with topics such as identifying weeds, insects, and diseases, identifying the growth stages of corn and soybean plants, assessing abiotic injury, pesticide application, and integrated pest management. Judges will score each team, and cash prizes will be awarded to the top four scores. The top two teams will also advance to compete against students in other states and represent Illinois at the Midwestern regional competition.

The registration deadline is June 30, and the event will be held from 8:00 am to 1:30 pm on August 1 at the University of Illinois Crop Sciences Research & Education Center.

Prize levels: 1st place - \$500, 2nd place - \$300, 3rd place - \$200, 4th place - \$100. Lunch, beverages & snacks will be provided.



### **State Hippology/Horse Bowl**

4-H members from Saline, White and Hamilton counties competed recently at the Illinois State 4-H Horse Bowl and Hippology contest. Big thanks go to their coach Raegan Smith for all she has done to get these participants ready for the contest. In Senior Hippology, Hannah Wenzel placed fifth and qualified for Nationals. Hannah also placed second in Senior Extemporaneous Speaking.

In Senior Horse Bowl, Hannah Wenzel and Annsley Healy from White County teamed up with members from Monroe County to win first place and qualify for Nationals. This team was also undefeated at both Regional and State. Hannah received Reserve High Point Individual.


#### **National Night Results**
