
**Lawn Mower Class:** Those in Junior group who do not feel comfortable on a larger tractor may enter the lawn mower class.

(for all animals except Dog and Cat)

Livestock records should be completed through July 1, 2023. Records will be due at time of check -in on Monday, July 24.

# **General Projects Day**

- You should have all picked up your exhibit tags or have plans to get them before the week of Fair.
- Your judging time and judge number is on your tag.
- You will need to attach the tag to your project *BEFORE* you arrive at the General Projects show.
- Bring your project goal sheets, it could be there are more than one per goal sheet.
- Please show up 10 minutes before your assigned time for judging.

If you are only showing livestock in the 4-H shows, you may leave after the auction on Thursday. However, if you are showing in the Richland County Jr. Fair shows, you must abide by their rules and stay until Friday afternoon release.
