We had six 4-Hers, Hailee Ellerman, Grace McCarty, Jalynn Phillips, Aaliya Robinson, and Johanna receive blue ribbons for their dogs. Hailee Ellerman received a Best of Show and Superior, with everyone else receiving a Superior. Jalynn Phillips, Johanna Zieren, and Remmington Naas received a blue ribbon in Dog Obedience, and Remmington Naas receiving a Best of Show.

Three 4-Hers, Kenley Davis, Aaliya Robinson, and Alexandria Vaupel were judged and given blue ribbons and Superiors for their cats with Alexandria receiving a Best of Show and Superior. Of the small pets a hermit crab was shown by Aaliya Robinson, she received a Best of Show and Superior. Hunter Robinson received a Best of Show and a Superior with his caged birds.

Drive that tractor

White County 4-H held their annual Tractor Driving Contest on Tuesday, July 11 at the White County Fairgrounds. A really big thank you goes out to Sydenstricker Nobbe Partners of Norris City for furnishing the tractor the members drove during the contest. The contestants must back the tractor with a two-wheeled wagon attached through a series of poles, then make two passes through the poles going opposite directions and then back in between poles and as near to a backstop as possible. The poles are set up so that the opening between them gives only three inches of clearance on each side of the trailer. They are timed and given penalties when they touch a pole or make other errors. Junior and Senior divisions were divided up this year.

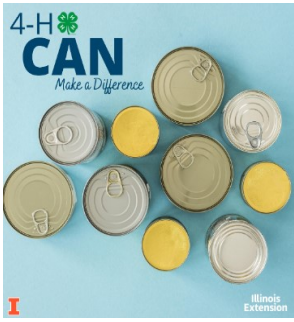

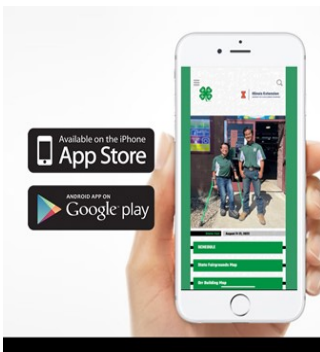

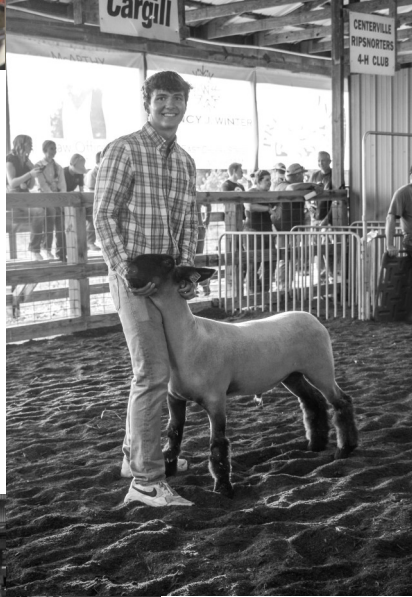

Area hunters can earn certification

Area residents will have an opportunity to learn basic principles of safe hunting at the Illinois Department of Natural Resources hunter safety certification course. Participants must attend **all 10 hours** of instruction and pass the test to receive their certification.

The workshop times are Tuesday, August 15 & Thursday, August 17 from 6-8pm and Saturday, August 19, 9am-3pm at the U of I Extension office in Carmi.

The course is geared toward youth, but older hunters are also encouraged to attend the classes since many states now require out-of-state hunters to show proof of certification. A 1996 Illinois law requires that all hunters born after Jan. 1, 1980 must successfully complete the hunter education course before they can receive their first hunting license. Participants completing the course receive a hunter education certification card which verifies they have passed the course.

The ten-hour course includes instruction in wildlife management, firearms safety, hunter ethics, game identification, first aid, survival techniques, and regulations. The lead instructor will again be Bobby Lamp.

Pre-registration is not required, but would be helpful. To register, one may call the Extension office at 382-2662 by August 15.
