Apply for this grant for the opportunity to receive ag-accurate books for your classroom library to *integrate agriculture* into a variety of curriculum areas.


HOW IT WORKS:

- 3. Apply for the grant at <u>http://iaitc.co/bookgrants</u> by Friday, October 20, 2023.
- 4. Successful grant recipients will:
 - Be notified via email by November 10, 2023.
 - Submit a Funding Agreement, signed by you and your building principal, by December 8, 2023. Failure to do so will forfeit the grant.
 - Receive your books shipped directly to your school.
 - Submit a Final Grant Report by Friday, May 31, 2024, to tell us how you used your books.

THE FINE PRINT:

- Classroom teachers and librarians in the state of Illinois are eligible to apply.
- Each educator may submit only <u>one</u> grant application.
- Book grants <u>may</u> be awarded to more than one educator in the same school.
- High school ag teachers <u>may</u> apply with an elementary teacher if their students/FFA members are working with a specific classroom.
- You may contact your county Ag Literacy Coordinator for help with this application.

Grant Amount: up to \$300.00

Apply for this grant for the opportunity to fund projects for *integrating agricultural literacy* in the classroom.

HOW IT WORKS:

- 1. Design a project for *integrating agriculture* into a variety of curriculum areas.
- 2. Make note of materials needed to complete your project.
- 3. Apply for the grant at <u>http://iaitc.co/projectgrants</u> by **Friday**, **October 20**, **2023**.
- 4. Successful grant recipients will:
 - Be notified via email by November 10, 2023.
 - Submit a Funding Agreement, signed by you and your building principal, by **December 8, 2023**. Failure to do so will forfeit the grant.
 - Receive a check for the agreed-upon amount from your grant application to purchase materials.
 - Submit a Final Grant Report by Friday, May 31, 2024, to tell us how your project went.

THE FINE PRINT:

- This grant will <u>not</u> fund consumable items, field trips, plants, or incubators. Priority will be given to grants that contain materials for use over multiple school years.
- Reviewers recommend that your grant request be used in its entirety for one specific project rather than linked to other potential funding.
- Each teacher may submit only <u>one</u> grant application.
- Project grants <u>may</u> be awarded to more than one teacher in the same school.
- High school ag teachers <u>may</u> apply with an elementary teacher if their students/FFA members are working with a specific classroom.
- You may contact your county Ag Literacy Coordinator for help with this application.
