Fresh Air Friday

- Spend at least 30 minutes outdoors.

- Plant something.

- Make a bird feeder.

STEAM Saturday

- Build or create something that lets you work with your hands and your imagination. Tell us about these life skills that you practiced through the experience: problem solving, patience, curiosity, resourcefulness, etc.

Be sure to record your activity participation by sharing photos and details to your local 4-H program coordinator throughout the week or no later than October 9.

Two members from each county will be recognized for the most participation (must complete/participate in at least 7 items). One club per county who has the highest percentage of members participating will win an ice cream sandwich party.
