2023 - 2024 BOND COUNTY HCE SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: April 3, 2023

Bond County Home and Community Education will provide annually at least one (1) \$500 scholarship to a young person who meets the following requirements:

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be a SENIOR attending BCCU1 or BCCU2 (affiliation with HCE is not required) OR
 - A SENIOR from a neighboring county high school whose parent is a member of Bond County HCE.
- 2. Application must be received by **APRIL 3**.
- 3. The minimum grade requirement (GPA) is 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Scholarship must be used for post-high school education (e.g., trade school, college, university).
- 5. These items MUST accompany your application:
 - a. Two letters of reference by non-relatives
 - b. A transcript of grades that includes your GPA
 - c. A recent photo

Selection of scholarship recipient will be completed by May 1. The student awarded the scholarship will be notified via email.

If, for any reason, the applicant does not enroll, the awarded scholarship is to be returned, in full, to the Bond County HCE Treasurer. The scholarship will then be awarded to the approved alternate.

Basic Concepts and Formation Ideals

- 1. The HCE County Board will appoint a five (5) member governing board, selected from HCE members. The County HCE Board President shall be a member of the board. No exact term of office was designated for the board members. It was recommended that terms be staggered to provide continuity.
- 2. The scholarship shall be awarded to a student who meets the eligibility requirement.
- 3. The HCE Scholarship Governing Board will be responsible for making the final decision.
- 4. The scholarship monies will be awarded in two \$250 payments to the institution the recipient attends. The <u>first payment</u> will be made upon receipt of a copy of your Fall 2023 bill <u>AND</u> your Fall 2023 class schedule. The <u>second payment</u> will be made when the recipient provides a Spring 2024 bill <u>AND</u> shows proof of having maintained the required GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale during Fall 2023. <u>To receive the second payment</u>, you must submit the necessary documents by **January 31**, 2024.

- 5. The Bond County HCE Board meets on the second Tuesday of each month. The Treasurer will issue a check to the institution within a week after the meeting.
- 6. An alternate will be selected and will receive the scholarship monies should the recipient not continue to meet the above stipulations.
