Enrollment

- Complete online **enrollment** for 2023-2024 at 4h.zsuite.org
- Pay the annual **Program Fee** (\$20/member; financial assistance is available)
- Read the weekly **Eblast emails** for important information. Sign up at go.illinois.edu/WeeklyBlast
- Members in grades 8-12 are encouraged to join Federation. Contact Brittany Smith

Project Work

Cloverbud 4-H members do their project work as a group. Older members do their project work independently.

- Choose at least 1 project**
April 1 - deadline to add/change projects *
- Order **project books by April 15th** through the Extension Office. After April 15, it is the member's responsibility.
- Watch the eblast for updates and information on live animal shows
- If exhibiting a live animal project, complete **ethics training**. Due July 1.
 - YQCA required annually if exhibiting Beef, Dairy, Goats, Sheep, or Swine - yqcaprogram.org
 - QAEC required once if exhibiting Cats, Dogs, Horses, Poultry, or Rabbits - web.extension.illinois.edu/qaec
- For large animals Health Papers are required. It's your responsibility to make sure you have them at check-in. No * papers - You will not show.

Participation

- Attend at least 3 club meetings *
- Complete 2-3 hours of community service.
- "Like" Edgar County 4-H (and your club) on **Facebook** to see announcements and reminders
- Keep track of what you do during the year for 4-H **Records**
- Give a talk/demonstration at a meeting
- Participate in the 4-H BBQ on June 22 *
- Participate in the Edgar County 4-H Show (July 13& July 19-24, 2024) *

Exhibiting

- July 13 & 19-24, 2024- Edgar County show date.** Specific dates/times will be in the show book and mailed to families
- Read the **Exhibit Requirements** for projects in the **Show Book** *
- Register** projects you plan to exhibit in Fairentry.com. (*Being enrolled in a project does not automatically register you to exhibit. Registration is required.*)
- Prepare exhibits** (*Parents can guide and assist with project work, but members are expected to complete their exhibits themselves.*)
- Check Requirements if you plan to go to State Fair
