Shelby County 4-H

Shelby County 4-H had 407 4-H members (including Cloverbuds) enrolled in 2022-2023. There are 43 club leaders who share their knowledge and love of 4-H with its members. Our 4-H program continues to grow because of the continued recruitment by 4-H members, participating in parades, trunk or treats, workshops and by all the families sharing their great experiences.

Shelby County 4-H has 13 community clubs, 4 SPIN Clubs, and 3 Cloverbud Clubs. The Shelby Sprouts was a new Cloverbud Club located at Trinity Lutheran School, led by Sherri Jesgarz.

Highlights from the year included 28 workshops that helped 4-H'ers learn more about projects and increase their knowledge. Craft day workshops, the Fall Round-Up and 4-H Fire-Up were led by Federation members, which let them use and enhance their leadership skills. We sponsored 4 Cloverbud only workshops. Shelby County 4-H also offers school programming and reached over 325 youth with Can Can Robots, Health Jam and STEM activities.

Due to the great success of the Awesome Autumn Photography Contest in 2021-2022, Shelby County 4-H Federation offered the photography contest again in 2022-2023. Three age divisions were offered with a total of \$200 in prize money awarded to 4-H and Cloverbud members. This type of activity also allows 4-H members to have a unit experience on their year-end experience awards. Shelby County 4-H had a total of 49 entries participate in the various photography contests. Unit 19 which serves Coles, Cumberland, Moultrie, Douglas and Shelby Counties had a unit wide officer training in Mattoon in January and also offered a unit community service project. 4-H'ers made Valentines Day Cards which were given to Shelbyville Manor residents.

There were 249 Shelby County 4-H members who exhibited at the Shelby County 4-H Fair, with a total of 1,614 exhibits. 56 Cloverbud members participated in the fair with 108 exhibits. 47 Cloverbuds came to Chit Chat with a Cloverbud and shared their projects with older 4-H members. At the IL State Fair General Projects Show, there were 51 members that exhibited with 13 awarded champion, 5 awarded reserve and 6 awarded Inspire Awards. Shelby County 4-H livestock exhibitors also placed well in the livestock shows.

At the heart of the Shelby County 4-H program is our generous 4-H leaders. Leaders give up their time and efforts to prepare for monthly club meetings, support club community service projects and provide guidance throughout the year through 4-H week activities, fair entries and year-end records. We couldn't do it without them and their support!

Thank you to all the 4-H members and families for making 2022-2023 another great year in Shelby County 4-H!

Illinois 4-H Experience Award

Illinois 4-H challenges youth to try new things, experiment in project areas they may enjoy and explore opportunities around the state and country. This is the seventh year for the Illinois 4-H Experience Recognition Award. The Experience Award offers recognition for members who participate in activities and events.

The Experience Award is based on four dimensions of experience: Participation, Community Service, Leadership and Project learning. The Bronze level award requires members meet 1 experience in each of the four dimensions. The Silver level award requires members meet 2 experiences in each of the four dimensions with at least two of those being at the county level or above. The Gold level award requires members to complete 4 experiences in each of the four dimensions with at least 2 of those experiences beyond the county level.

This is the seventh year Shelby County 4-H members have participated in this awards program. There were a total of 42 applications as well as three that were sent to the State 4-H Office for judging.

Federation Projects

Shelby County 4-H Federation members are always busy planning fun workshops and activities for 4-H members throughout the year. Federation assisted with multiple craft days, the Fall Round-Up, 4-H Fire-up, Cloverbud Fire-Up, 4-H week activities, worked the 4-H BBQ, were Cloverbud judges at the fair and kept the pop stand full of cold drinks.

Harvest time means packing harvest bags to share with our 4-H farm families and Shelby County farmers. Federation packed 425 harvest bags which were delivered to Shelby County grain elevators and area farmers. Many members worked the Festival of Lights donation booth as well as Shelbyville Food Distributions.

The Community Service Workshop is an important project for Federation. They assist in leading this workshop with younger 4-H members and are excited to provide Christmas presents to Shelby Rehab and The Hawthorne Inn. In 2022-2023, Shelby County 4-H Federation received two \$1,000 IL State Food Advocacy Grants. Backpack Buddies provided 90 backpacks to Kindergarten through Second grades at Cowden Herrick Grade School. Each youth who received a backpack also received a new toothbrush kit. Backpacks were delivered at Valentines Day.

In early summer, Federation packed 240 Summer Sacks for Windsor Grade School. 40 Summer Sacks were given out for six weeks. The sacks were distributed on Fridays to help with food insecurity over the weekends. The Food Grants are important to Federation members because it lets them give back and help youth in need in our communities. Grants also give members the opportunity to develop a shopping list, write and implement the grant. Members also write the final report and that includes the impact of the grant.
