PINE CONE FEEDER

WHAT YOU NEED A pine cone Peanut butter or vegetable shortening Birdseed String



PREPARATION

1. Attach the string to the pine cone.

- 2. Cover the pine cone in peanut butter or vegetable shortening, getting between the cracks and crevices of the cone.
- 3. Roll the pine cone in the birdseed, slightly pushing down so the seeds stick, covering it completely with seed.
- 4. Place it outside near a window to watch the birds enjoy their treat.
