The Illinois 4-H Junior Leadership Conference (JLC) is a fun-filled event which provides junior high 4-H members (7th & 8th grades) a look into opportunities in Illinois 4-H and helps start their leadership journey. Members gain skills related to 4-H projects and leadership, such as communication, decision making, and teamwork while engaging in hands-on activities.

Registration deadline: October 13, 2023

- Registration is limited to the first 100 youth who register.
- Participants are encouraged to register early as this conference usually reaches capacity before the registration deadline. A waitlist will be activated once capacity is reached.

How to register: Participants may visit the Jr. Leadership Conference website to register.

Required forms: All forms will be included in the online registration form.

Scholarships: Scholarship funds are available for 4-H member attendees who need financial assistance in order to attend. To apply, fill out the information requested on the conference registration. Your spot will be saved until we contact you regarding your scholarship status. We appreciate the support of the Illinois 4-H Foundation for providing these scholarships.

Payment options during registration:

- 1. Members pay on their own by **credit card** at the time of registration.
- 2. **My County is Paying.** Some (not all) counties may be able to assist with the registration fee. Members need to check with local extension staff prior to registration. A list will be sent to counties prior to the conference to verify that county will pay.
- 3. Scholarship needed. Members will apply directly during the conference registration process.

Counties Supplementing or Paying for Registration Fee:

- Counties may pay for the entire registration fee by doing a transfer of funds form and contacting Karen Bickers, <u>kbickers@illinois.edu</u> to complete that process.
- If county is paying for only a portion of the registration fee, counties need to collect any remaining amount of the registration fee directly from families. Families may register their member and select the 'county is paying' option.

Cancellations & Refunds: Cancellations made by Oct. 1, 2023 will receive a full refund. Please let us know if you cannot attend so that we may let someone on the waiting list have the opportunity to experience this event. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after Oct. 1, 2023 as event supplies have already been ordered. Rockin' the Universe with Leadership
