Have leftover pumpkin puree? Work with an adult to make this yummy dip perfect for crackers or celery sticks.


## PUMPKIN PEANUT BUTTER DIP

### INGREDIENTS

- 3/4 cup canned pumpkin puree
- 3/4 cup peanut butter
- 1-2 Tbsp brown sugar, to taste
- 1 teaspoon vanilla


### PREPARATION

1. Mix peanut butter and brown sugar.
2. Add vanilla and stir.
3. Add pumpkin and stir until well blended.
4. Refrigerate or serve immediately with graham crackers, apple slices, or celery sticks. Note: A serving is 2 Tablespoons.



**Q: What do you get if you divide the circumference of a pumpkin by its diameter?**







**What sound does a turkey's phone make?**
