Ag in the Classroom is a program that delivers agriculture activity based curriculum to supplement children in the community. Topics include dairy, horses, pumpkins, apples, soil, pollinators, pigs, poultry, etc. Last school year, we reached 12 out of the 13 primary schools in Adams County with a total of 31 agricultural topics and lesson programs.

National Ag Week

To promote National Ag Week, 12 of our 13 Adams County Schools participated in a coloring contest. Each grade colored a different agricultural scene and one winner was chosen from each grade. In total, 1,057 students participated across 74 classrooms.





Adams County Fair Ag Tent

During the 2023 Adams County Fair, the Ag Tent offered daily lessons and crafts. Each day was a different theme in agriculture. Crafts included: animal puppets, coloring sheets, animal masks, cow milking, and corn, soybeans, and wheat bins for sensory. Over 360 youth and 170 adults took part in our Ag Tent activities.
