Horse & Pony Classes

Saline County 4-H Horse & Pony are reminded to return their Class Sign Up forms by Friday, July 12, 2024. Forms were mailed to Horse & Pony exhibitors at the end of May.

In an effort to speed along the folder sign-up process prior to the 4-H Horse & Pony Show and begin on time, please complete this form and return to the Extension office no later than Friday, July 12th.

Entries from these forms will be drawn at random and listed in the folder by class.

Entries may be added or deleted on show day, July 23, 2024. Exhibitor numbers will be available on show day and entered into folders at that time.

Bred & Owned Classes

We will be offering Bred & Owned Champion and Reserve Champion classes for Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Swine, Sheep, and Beef this year. To enter this class, the female must have been bred and the animal born and raised on your farm or property.

4-H members who wish to enter the Bred & Owned class can sign up the day of their species show. Youth may show one animal per class. Breeding and/or Market animals may be shown. Most species will have separate competitions for breeding and market classes.

The Bred & Owned class(es) for each species will be shown at the conclusion of each species show. (These are not 4-H classes. No 4-H ribbons or premiums will be awarded.)











Southern Region 4-H Showcase at the DuQuoin State Fair

I have been asked to bring to your attention again the Southern Region 4-H Showcase exhibition at the Du Quoin State Fair - open to all 4-Hers in the lower 49 counties. There will be Rosettes for General Projects and Banners for Livestock.

Registration for the event opened March 1 and will close on August 1.

General Projects show will be Saturday, August 17 (the Saturday before the Du Quoin State Fair starts). 4-H Exhibitors may enter a maximum of 3 projects and will be able to keep their project(s) up through the end of the Fair.

The Goat and Sheep Shows as well as the Swine Weigh-in will be held on Friday, August 23. The Beef, Dairy, and Swine Shows will be held on Saturday, August 24. There will be a \$5 stalling fee per animal.
