DAY OF PROCEDURE

- Begin at the check-in table (Main Show Arena)
- Arrive at the arena early to walk and let your dog sniff.
- After you walk the arena, take your dog to the East (opposite) end of the Barn.
- Make sure you are not too close to other dogs.
- Ensure your dog, and you have used the bathroom before the show begins.
- Bring shot records/ papers with you.
- Note: If you are showing a General Project & your name is called while participating in the Dog Show. Your name will be shifted to the bottom of the General Project list, and your project will be judged later in the day.

NEED TO KNOW

- How old is your dog?
- What food do you use?
- Did you bathe your dog before the show?
- Don't forget to speak sternly to your dog.
- Bring water and treats.
- Reminder NO treats allowed in the arena.

AWARDS PRESENTATION

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the show.

REMINDER

- Don't forget to give your dog a bath and a good brush before the show!
- Arrive no later than 6:00 p.m.
