>>> ELECTRICITY SCHOOL: AN ELECTRIFYING EXPERIENCE

On June 5th, 68 youth gathered at Bailey Park, in Camp Point, IL, for an electrifying day of fun and learning! Sponsored by Adams Electric, University of Illinois Extension, and Gem City Electric, this free event was all about electricity and safety.

Youth aged 8-18 played a giant Scrabble game, watched a cool bucket truck safety demo, and joined five awesome workshops:

- Beginners learned the basics of electricity and even made their own extension cords to take home.
- Second-year students turned soda cans into solar cars!
- Third-year students got hands-on with house wiring in their circuits and switches class.
- Fourth-year students toured the unique Pigeon Creek Wind Turbine.
- Fifth-year students explored the Co-op's mapping system and checked out an electric car.


