- Submit most recent college transcripts, or letter of acceptance from institution for first semester students, with application to be considered.

*Previous awardees of this scholarship may reapply; however, preference will be given to qualified applicants who have not received the award before.

Applications are due to the Livingston County Extension office by **October 1, 2024**.

Awards

Five applicants will each receive a \$500 scholarship to go towards their educational pursuits. Checks will be made out to the member's College/Institution.
