Please join us **Thursday**, **December 12th** to represent Saline County 4-H and walk in the Harrisburg Christmas Lights parade. The parade begins at 6 pm. Our float is usually parked in front of East Side Intermediate School on Church Street in Harrisburg. Arrive no later than 5:30 p.m.

A parent/guardian must accompany any 4-H youth 10 years or younger. Wear comfortable shoes and dress appropriately for the weather - it could be very COLD! You must "light" yourself with battery lights (we have some battery lights that we will bring). Wear your favorite Christmas clothes or Santa hat. Come and join your 4-H friends and celebrate Christmas!

VERY IMPORTANT...

The Parade ends at Southern FS/Lion's Club on South Main Street. The float will not come back to East Side School, and since I am walking, I cannot transport you back. You must make arrangements for someone to meet you at the end of the parade route. Any youth not accompanied by an adult will have to make arrangements with Nancy ahead of time to walk to meet a parent/family member after the parade.

Winners will be notified and announced on December 16th. And the winners can collect their prize at the Extension office through December 20th.





















Virtual Ornament Workshop

Congratulations! We are so proud of you Hannah and team!







4-H Enrollment/Re-Enrollment in ZSuite

ZSuite is now open. Emails with instructions went out in October to all current members and adult volunteers. If you would prefer a paper enrollment form, please let our office know. The enrollment fee in 4-H is \$20 per child.

Illinois 4-H has a maximum per family enrollment fee of \$60 or 3 youth. To receive the multi-child discount for the fourth member, choose pay by check as the method of payment. Our office will then be able to apply the multi child discount. If you have problems with re-enrolling, please contact our office. We are looking forward to a great 2024-25 4-H year.

Have you been attending meetings or events for the 2024-25 year already? If so, your enrollment should be complete and your enrollment fee paid, in order to be covered by the insurance policy. If you have not enrolled, do so ASAP!

For Your Information

You will often see RSVP and a date/time to do so in the newsletter or on a flyer or Facebook post. Or you will see a deadline to submit 4-H paperwork, forms, records, contest entries, etc.

Those RSVP dates and deadlines are listed for a reason. Perhaps we are providing supplies or food and need time to prepare. Or, more likely, we want to make things fair for everyone, or we are, in turn, meeting a state deadline and need you to meet your deadline.

I encourage club leaders to adhere to these RSVP dates and deadlines and to remind your club members to do so also. It's good to get youth in the practice of being "on time".

These deadlines will be strongly enforced at the county level.

ATTENTION 4-H ARTISTS - 4-H HANDBOOK COVER CONTEST

4-H members of all ages...It's time for the 2025 4-H Handbook Cover Contest.

- 1. Submit original design on white paper (8 1/2 X 11 in).

- 4. Use the words "Saline County 4-H" and the year "2025" somewhere on your design.
- 5. Put your name, your age, and your 4-H Club on the front of your entry.
- 6. Entry should reflect 4-H in Saline County.
- 7. If you want to use a clover in your design, we request that you use the official 4-H emblem. Contact the Extension office and we will print out a 4-H Clover for your use.
- 8. One entry per 4-H member may be submitted.
- 9. Entries must be received by 4 pm on Friday, January 31, 2025.

Remember, there is a monetary prize at Achievement Night for the winner.

New Livestock Requirement for Beef and Swine Exhibitors



We wanted to give you a heads up and plenty of time to take advantage of this new requirement for Beef and Swine Exhibitors.

Beginning in 2025, individual identification of each Beef and Swine animal shall be by a USDA official animal identification number ear tag, ("840" tag). The tag must be able to be read both visually and electronically.

Producers can order tags directly, including through the free tag program with the Department of Ag, or utilize your veterinarian. This link will give you information on ordering tags: Animal Disease Traceability (illinois.gov).


This second link is 2024 County Fair Health Requirements. When you open it, changes for 2025 are in red https://agr.illinois.gov/animals/animalhealth/fair-exhibition-requirements.html

If you are raising animals on your own farm, you have to have a premise ID to order 840 tags.

These steps will need to be taken before the 2025 weigh-ins (Likely Weigh-In dates are Beef on Feb. 1 and Swine on April 5). If you purchase your livestock from someone else you will need to make sure they have registered 840 tags and are already tagged or you will need to tag the animal with your tag before the weigh-in.

This is a MANDATORY requirement by the state. Please take care of ordering and tagging your animals, so there is no chance of not being able to exhibit at the 2025 Saline County 4-H livestock shows





2025 Junior Livestock Conference - Wild, Wild West Jan. 25-26, 2025 - Crowne Plaza Hotel, Springfield

Come join the State 4-H Livestock Ambassador Team and get hands-on experience at this year's Junior Livestock Conference! This year's theme is the Wild, Wild West and provides activities built around the science and disciplines of livestock production and exhibition.

The Crowne Plaza Springfield is located at 3000 S. Dirksen Parkway, Springfield, IL.

This conference is only offered every other year and is open to any 4-H member in 7th, 8th, or 9th grades. Youth must be enrolled in ZSuite prior to registration.

Cost for this conference in \$170. This fee covers lodging, a conference t-shirt, meals, conference supplies and all activities.

The deadline to register is January 2, 2025. But don't delay if you want to attend. The conference is limited to the first 100 youth who register. This conference usually reaches capacity before the registration deadline. A waitlist will be activated once capacity is reached.
