## >>> APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES

As you noticed, it is time for the 4-H Fair Book Cover Contest. All submissions are due to your county coordinator by January 31, 2025. Here are the guidelines to meet:

- Drop off entries to your Extension Office or email
   Design must include the 4-H Clover logo. Email to your County Coordinator by the deadline
- Design must fit neatly on a white, 8½ x 11 sheet
   Use of copyrighted images is not allowed for of paper, with room for binding on left margin
- · Design must be black and white with the title of the fair/county program included
- Design may be done on computer or by hand
- your County Coordinator for the correct file.
- example: a name-brand tractor or cartoon character
- Include name, age, and contact number with the design (do not include on the deisgn)
