In honor of many great 4-H supporters, the Clay County 4-H Foundation is offering a scholarship to encourage Clay County 4-H'ers to continue their education beyond high school. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded. Selection is based on 4-H accomplishments, leadership, academic performance, and community service.

Guidelines:

- 1. Must be a current 4-H member who is a high school senior attending an accredited college/university or trade school this fall or a 4-H member who is currently a freshman at an accredited college/university.
- 2. Must be a member of Clay County 4-H for at least four years.
- 3. No single recipient may receive more than one award.
- 4. You must submit two letters of recommendation (non-family members) in a sealed envelope, along with your application.
- 5. Return to Clay County Extension office by <u>April 11th, 2025</u>, by 11:59 pm. Applications may be dropped off at the extension office or mailed (210 S Church St., PO Box 301, Louisville, IL 62858).
