Dear Ogle County 4-H Member:

As you may know, the Ogle County 4-H Foundation has offered educational scholarships for the past several years to Ogle County 4-H members. In addition, the Ogle County Farm Bureau offers the "Stan Eden 4-H Scholarship" to pay tribute to Stan Eden who dedicated over 34 years to serving Ogle County Extension and 4-H. These scholarships are offered because both organizations believe in the importance of continuing education and recognize the financial strain paying for college can put on a family, particularly in this economy.

Please see the enclosed information to determine whether you are eligible for these scholarships. We send applications to all enrolled 4-Hers who <u>MAY</u> be eligible--it is up to you to determine if you actually qualify based on your years of 4-H membership and other qualifying factors. You must have been in 4-H for 6 years (including current year) in any county.

Scholarships are offered each spring to 4-Hers who are planning to pursue or are already engaged in further education beyond high school, whether that is at a college or vocational institution. Any area of study may be pursued. 4-Hers selected by the Ogle County 4-H Foundation will receive scholarships amounting to \$400 per year of full-time course work for a maximum of four years (max of \$1600). One 4-Her will be chosen for the "Stan Eden 4-H Scholarship," which is a one-time award of \$1,000.

For the 2025 Ogle County 4-H Foundation and Stan Eden 4-H Scholarships, we will accept applications postmarked by Friday, March 28, 2025. Qualified applicants may be asked to interview with the committee. Interviews will take place on Friday, April 4, 2025. You will be informed of your interview time after receipt of application and confirmation of eligibility. You will be notified of the results within a week of the interview date.

Please give this opportunity your serious consideration. This is not an academic scholarship. Review the enclosed application materials, and send in your <u>completed</u> application by the deadline. Only those submitting "complete" applications as described in the enclosure will be considered. The application is also available at our website, https://extension.illinois.edu/bdo/4-h-ogle-county. OGLE COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

SCHOLARSHIPS:

There are two scholarship opportunities offered through the Ogle County 4-H Foundation:

- 1. The <u>Foundation Scholarship</u> is awarded to Ogle County 4-Hers who meet the qualifications listed below. This scholarship provides <u>\$400 per year</u> of full-time course work for a maximum of 4 years.
- 2. The Ogle County Farm Bureau <u>"Stan Eden 4-H Scholarship"</u> is offered to one 4-Her who meets the qualifications listed below <u>AND</u> is also an Ogle County Farm Bureau member or a dependent of a member. This scholarship is a <u>one-time</u> <u>payment of \$1,000</u>. The <u>current</u> Co-op Watch Award winner is not eligible for this scholarship.

Scholarship recipients must be planning for full-time course work at any accredited college or vocational school in any area of study.

QUALIFICATIONS:

For both scholarships, the following qualifications must be met:

- 1. Applicants must be currently enrolled Ogle County 4-H members who have been active in 4-H for a minimum of six years (may include present year).
- 2. Applicants must be completing/have completed high school with at least a 2.5 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) in course work at the time of application.

 Complete high school/college transcripts are to be submitted with the application.

3. Applicants must complete and submit the 4-H Foundation/"I Dare You" Award Application in addition to the scholarship application. A previously submitted award application should be updated to reflect recent accomplishments.

As mentioned previously, the Stan Eden 4-H scholarship has the added requirement of Farm Bureau membership which will be determined through current Farm Bureau records.

TO APPLY:

Applications may be mailed to the Ogle County 4-H Foundation, P.O. Box 393, Oregon, IL 61061. Applications should be postmarked by March 28, 2025. A complete application includes: a) 2-page scholarship application; b) current 4-H Foundation/"I Dare You" Award Application; and c) complete high school transcripts. The scholarship packet can also be found at our website https://extension.illinois.edu/bdo/. Click on "County Awards/Scholarship" in the grey box. The Ogle County 4-H Foundation & Stan Eden 4-H Scholarship can be found at the bottom of that tab.

PROCESSING THE APPLICATION:

Criteria used for selection will include: a) 4-H involvement and achievement at both the club and county levels as evidenced by the 4-H Foundation/"I Dare You" Award Application; b) scholastic achievement as evidenced by transcripts and application information; and c) financial need as evidenced by application information. 4-H involvement is given greater priority than the other two criteria.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a committee consisting of three members of the Board of the Ogle County 4-H Foundation and one member of the Farm Bureau Board.

As part of the selection process, interviews may be conducted with all qualified applicants. Interviews will take place on April 4, 2025. We will notify eligible applicants of final interview date(s). If you plan to apply, please hold this date and notify the Extension office if you have a conflict/preference.

PAYMENT: Payment will be made after receipt of proof of admission and full-time attendance. All payments will be made directly to the school to be credited to the scholarship recipient's student account.
