

Reverse Triangle


The same as the "Triangle" only in reverse, you go up the diagonal first.

The "T"

Important to try and center yourself and your dog so that both directions are even



The T


Down and Back with another handler

In the event of a "Runoff" you could be asked to do a down and back with another handler


Leave together and come back together

Down and Back with Another Handler: Returning


Appearance of Your Dog
