QAEC TRAININGS

Quality Assurance and Ethics Training— The Quality Assurance and Ethics training is required for all youth that enroll in horse, rabbit, poultry, dog, cavy (guinea pigs), and cat. Members must take the training whether they own a live animal or not. It is advised that they complete this as soon as they are enrolled in the project area. 4-H Members only have to complete a QAEC training once in their 4-H career, when showing a live animal or doing animal science with the above breeds.

Counties will monitor completion of this. Failure to complete QAEC will result in the member's animal science project enrollment being cancelled and they will be ineligible to exhibit at county fairs. The website is open year round at: https://web.extension.illinois.edu/qaec/

YQCA TRAINING

If you are a 4-H Member showing: **sheep, swine, dairy, goats, or beef** you will need to do your Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) training again **BE-FORE the June 1 deadline**. This is for all members ages 8-18 showing livestock for a 4-H show.

1)**Online training** (there is a test at the end) and the cost is \$12, per student. Once completed please print 2 copies of your certificate— 1 needs to be given to the Extension office before June 1, and the other one travels with the 4-H member to the shows.

Whether you take the online course OR attend an in-person training, you MUST submit your certificate of completion to Brenda at the Extension office—NO LAT-ER than 4pm on June 1.

SCHOLARSHIPS



R.C. Miller Scholarship— The scholarship was established by R. C. Miller, a lifetime Stephenson County resident and ardent supporter of agriculture, natural resources and conservation. Miller, who died in 2007, left a legacy in the community for his support of a variety of programs and efforts, especially youth and conservation causes.

To be eligible to apply, individuals must be residents of Stephenson County and enrolled in an agriculture, natural resources or related degree program. Applicants must be accepted at their chosen college or university and be a full-time student carrying a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
