



4-H Club Contests January - May 2023



January - February: Birthday Bags cookies or cupcakes

Clubs with the most creative method of collection AND highest percentage of items collected! 4-H Signage should be present. Collection site should be on display for at least 30 days. Birthday Bags will gift a birthday treat to those who may not be fortunate enough to have those supplies. Suggested items for collection include dry cake mix, frosting, candles,, sprinkles, cupcake liners, etc. Items collected should be delivered to local Extension office by March 3.



March: Easter Meal Bingo

Club with most creative method of collection AND club with highest percentage of items collected! 4-H signage should be present. Collect items related to an Easter dinner, found on your bingo sheet. Items collected should be delivered to local Extension office by March 27.



April-May: Pack the Bag

Donut Party

Club who gets a business to join in on the fun of sponsoring an employee challenge to help 4-H clubs meet their goals. Collection items will be for kids who have been placed with DCFS. 4-H Signage should be present. Collection site should be on display for at least 30 days. Suggested items for collection include: suitcase, duffle bags, toiletries, blankets, warm clothes, hats/socks etc. Items collected should be delivered to local Extension Office by June 2.



Tips & Tricks:

- Have each participating member tag 3 Friends/Family Members and let them know they're "It" for whatever the specific challenge is
- Have each participating member reach out to 3 businesses and ask them to support your challenge somehow. Let us know who these partners are so we can give them a social media shout out!

All of our Club Contests will have a service component this year. Please join us in giving back to your community. We have a goal set for the year of collecting 1500 items/per county. We will have a visual goal meter at the local Extension Office and we will be keeping track of our progress all year long. Please help us fill the progress meter!
