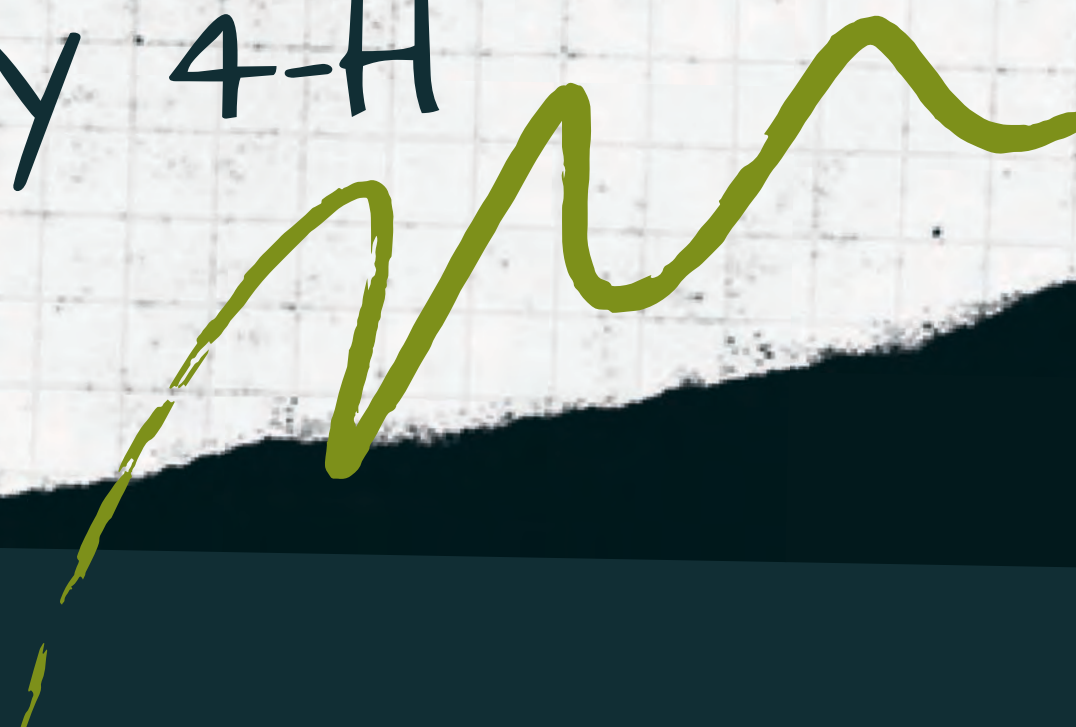

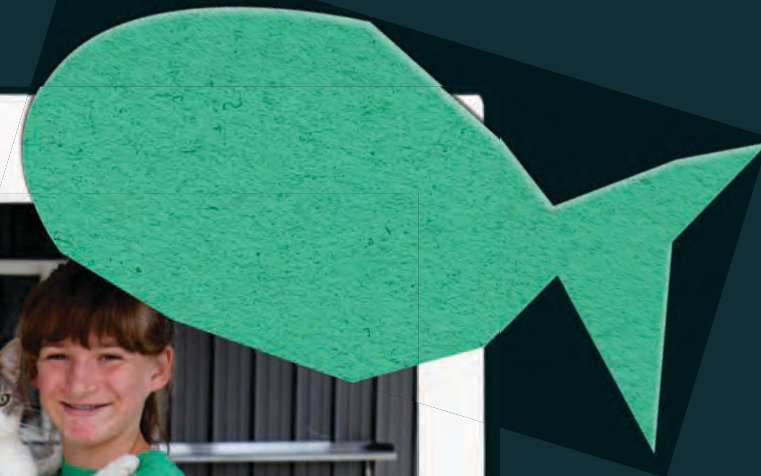


Public Speaking Contest



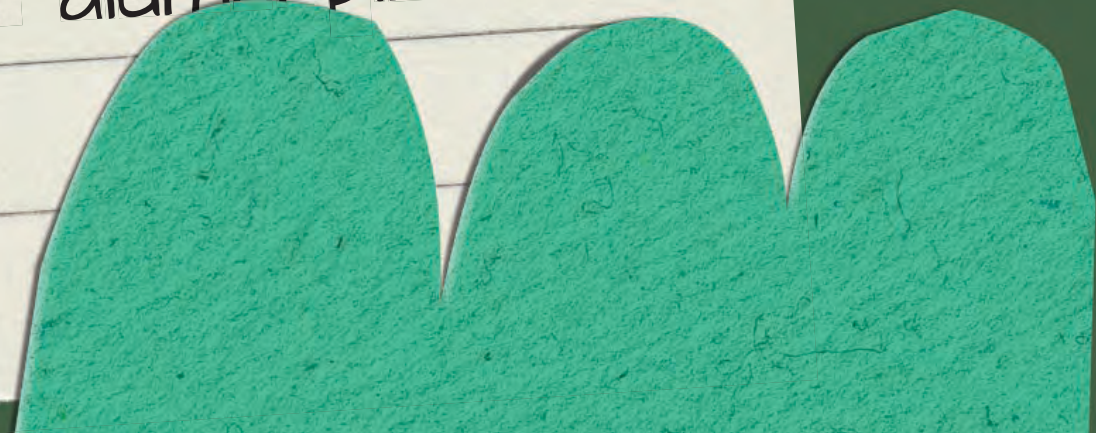




Tenure Members
