Adams County 4-H Foundation – Giving to Help Youth Grow

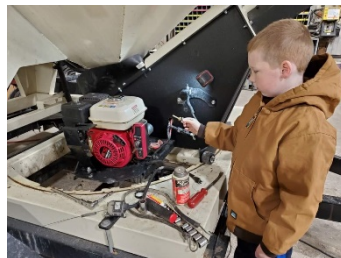

3. Get all required signatures from 4-Her, parent, and a leader.
5. Email, Fax, drop off or send completed form with all signatures to Adams County 4-H Foundation or local 4-H office. Please allow ample time to process before payment deadline.
6. Please note that no money will be issued to the 4-Her or parent, but directly to vendor or event sponsor.
7. Communication and attention to detail is important.
