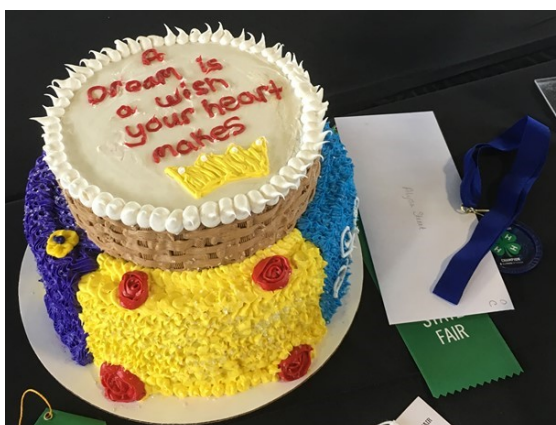

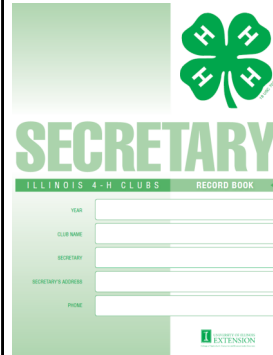
Lawrence County was well represented at the Illinois State Fair with these youth. Lawrence County had 12 youth exhibit at the Illinois State Fair!

- ♦ **New this year**, there will be a program fee of \$10 for all youth enrolling in 4-H. (More information to come).
