State Fair Notes

- You **must** have an entry tag affixed to your project when dropping it off. These tags are included in your state fair packets, which were either mailed or can be picked up in the office depending on the county.
- Follow the instructions included with your packets about when to drop off your projects, return for judging, and pick up projects.
- State Fair tickets have been ordered. You will be contacted when they arrive. All tickets must be picked-up from an office. We are not mailing tickets unless special arrangements are made. You can pay for the tickets when you pick them up. You can let us know which office you prefer for pickup and we will accommodate.
- Drop off passes are available for those with large, heavy or awkward projects. These passes allow you to drive up to the Orr Building and drop off the project before exiting and finding parking. They do not allow you to park in the Orr Building parking area. If you would like a drop off pass, please request one when picking up your admission tickets or let your county program coordinator know.
- If your plans change and you can no longer attend State Fair, please let us know ASAP. It throws off scheduling when someone does not show up. We can let the state fair know to remove you from the list up until Thursday, August 11.
- There is an App for State Fair that will let you know when projects can be picked up and alert you to other fun events. Download via the appropriate app store.


